Crossing the border with Turkey you were abandoned by your smugglers. Stranded in a mountain village on the border you were helped by a Turkish family. You have reached Istanbul and you want to transfer them some money to cover their expenses when looking after you.

Before leaving Istanbul, go to Taksim and pay







Things got ugly during a bomb rain in Damascus where you and your daughter barely made it out in time. Traumatised by the events she hasn't spoken a word since. You need to take her to an Imam to help her deal with her experiences

Before leaving Istanbul, spend two consecutive days in Faith.










You and your family left Baghdad a month ago. You hired smugglers to smuggle you into Turkey, but while crossing the border your 14-year-old son was separated from the rest of the family. He will hopefully reach Istanbul on his own and you want to leave messages for him in places where refugees pass through.

Before leaving Istanbul, visit Taksim, Faith and Uskudar in any order that suits you








You have made it all the way from Afghanistan to Istanbul without a passport but in Greece you will need to interact with authorities to gain asylum. Before continuing your journey you need to arrange documents to prove your nationality.

Before Leaving Istanbul, go to Taksim. Two days later go to Fatih.





Your old teacher has several friends who now work for smugglers in Istanbul Organising boat crossings to Greece. If you want you may pay them a visit.

Go to Taksim on a day when a journey is offered there. From the next day and on following days you are prioritized over other players and get a 5000 TL discount when a journey is offered.








Your brothers wife has family in Istanbul. They are well connected and know what goes on in the city. If you want, you may pay them a visit to see if they can help you find your way around.

Spend two consecutive days in Kadiköy. You may then look at one extra event card every turn.








Some people from back home have collected money to help you on your journey. If you want, you may arrange a money transfer to a bank in Istanbul.


Go to Taksim to arrange the transfer. Then go back to Taksim on one of the following three days to collect 10 000 TL.





Your mother used to do business with people from Istanbul. Among them is an official at the police department. If you want, you may seek him out and introduce yourself to mitigate future problems with the police.

Go to Fatih and then go to Taksim and pay 2000 TL. Then you may subtract 3000 TL from every fine you pay to the police.







Having worked at the Department of Industry in your home country your are familiar with the bureaucracy involved with employment. If you want, you may arrange the necessary papers to get a work permit in Istanbul.

Go to Fatih and then go to Taksim. You may now ignore police raids in any neighbourhood where a work possibility is.
